- F.** The (**Father / Mother**) will have _____ consecutive/ non-consecutive (circle one) weeks to be with the child(ren) in the summer from June 1st until August 1st provided the children are not in school. During this period, the (**Mother / Father**) can have the child(ren) on the weekend directly between the two weeks from _____ p.m. _____ (day of week) until _____ p.m. on _____ (day of week). The (**Father / Mother**) agrees to give the other parent a minimum of 30 days advance written notice of (his / her) intent to exercise the summer vacation;

- H.** Holidays shall take precedent over weekend visitation;

- I.** Visitation pick-up for the Father will be at the Mother's residence. Visitation pick-up for the Mother shall be at the Father's residence. Father and Mother agree to each bear their own transportation costs;

- J.** In the event either party is more than 30 minutes late to a visitation pick-up and does not call to notify the other parent he/she is running late; that parent agrees to forfeit his/her visitation for that time period;
