## Abbreviated Outline of Procedures for Domestic Relations Case Filings Flint, Griffin and Towaliga Judicial Circuits

(For more information consult the Guide to Mediation for Domestic Relations Case Filings for the 6th Judicial Circuit)

### **PETITIONER:**

- 1. Completes Domestic Relations Initiation Form (DRIF).
- 2. Serves the Respondent with:
  - (a) Copy of the Complaint
  - (b) Copy of "Guide to ADR"
- 3. Sends the ADR Office (within 5 days after service upon Respondent)
  - (a) Petitioner's DRIF (all pages completed)
  - (c) Copy of Complaint
- 4. Consult opposing counsel regarding selection of a neutral and possible dates for an ADR session.

### **RESPONDENT:**

- 1. Sends the ADR Office (within 5 days of the answer being due or filed)
  - (a) Respondent's DRIF (all pages completed)
  - (c) Copy of Answer and/or counterclaim (if filed)
- 2. If the ADR session has not already been scheduled, coordinate the selection of a neutral with opposing counsel and schedule the first session.
